## Nebraska 4-H Shooting Sports Leader Training

A registration fee of \$65 per person will guarantee you a spot in the training which includes meals, use of facility, program materials and lodging. The Dodge County 4-H Council will cover the registration cost of \$65 for any Dodge County 4-H leader attending the Shooting Sports Leader Training.
