Dodge County 4-H Council Scholarships

The Dodge County 4-H Council is offering five college scholarships to current high school senior and college freshmen who are currently enrolled in the Dodge County 4-H Program. The applicant may not be older than 18 years of age on January 1, 2008. Two \$1,000 scholarships will be awarded in the name of Lester A. Walker Foundation and four \$500.00 scholarships in the name of Dodge County 4-H Council. Application deadline is April 1, 2008. NACEB Scholarship Program

The Nebraska Association of County Extension Boards (NACEB) Scholarship Program for the 2008/09 academic year includes the following:

- One \$1000 scholarship at the University of Nebraska-Lincoln College of Agricultural Sciences and Natural Resources (CASNR) or in the College of Education and Human Sciences (CEHS) for an incoming student (freshmen or transfer student).
- One \$500 scholarship for a current student (sophomore or higher) enrolled in CASNR or CEHS.

The entire application, review, and award process of the NACEB Scholarship Program will be overseen by the Dean of the College of Agricultural Sciences and Natural Resources (CASNR) and the Dean of the College of Education and Human Sciences (CEHS) at the University of Nebraska-Lincoln. Contact the UNL Extension Office in Dodge County for an application. Applications must be received by March 15, 2008.

Nebraska Crop Improvement Association Scholarship

The Nebraska Crop Improvement Association has a Scholarship Fund to provide tuition assists to University of Nebraska agronomy students. Students applying for the Nebraska Crop Improvement Freshman Scholarships must be a new student enrolling at the University of Nebraska. They must possess a strong interest in agriculture and the seed industry. Student must be enrolled in a degree program offered by the Department of Agronomy and Horticulture. This scholarship will be for \$1000 (freshman year only). Scholarship money will be deposited directly into the students UNL account (\$500 per semester) to be used for tuition and/or books. Funding of scholarships are a function of the NCIA Board of Directors. Applications are available at the NCIA office. Scholarship requests

- Students may apply for and receive the scholarship more than one year

- Enrollment in program to pursue a career in family and consumer sciences, textiles and design, quilt or museum studies or related field of interest.
- Minimum GPA of 2.75 on a 4.0 scale or equivalent.
